



General Information CHBAD 2010 Futurity and Fun Show

All entries are due by September 10/10 and must be accompanied by:

Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the show committee until 8 am on Sept. 18.

All horses must be registered (or registration pending) with the CHBA and must be entered by registered owner or leasee. A third party may show the horse and must have proof of insurance.

Classes may be combined or cancelled at the discretion of the show committee depending upon the number of entries received. A class with one entry may be held for demonstration purposes if appropriate.

Safety is a priority. A tack judge will be available to inspect saddles, carts, harness etc. The judge may excuse any unsafe vehicle or tack, unruly horse or driver/rider that is not in control. All riders must have appropriate footwear (boot with low heel). All junior riders (18 & under) must wear approved riding helmet.

Venue

Deverness Stables is near Antigonish, Nova Scotia. It is required that horses be vaccinated for Flu and Rhyno. Stabling is available but we must know by Sept 13 how many stalls are required as

the stalls are temporary & must be assembled. On site are two indoor arenas. The smaller at 60 X120 feet can be used for warm-up and will be the home of a few temporary stalls. The show itself will take place in the Megadome which, at 80 X 180 feet will be large enough to allow both riding and driving classes. Weather permitting, we will also be using the grass dressage ring at 40 X 80 meters.

It is very easy to find Deverness Stables. Access is via Hwy 104, the Trans Canada. If coming from the west (past Truro for example), turn at exit 30 (James River exit) At the top of the exit ramp, turn LEFT, proceed 500 meters, then turn RIGHT. Travel 4.5 kilometers to Civic Number 1851. There is a LEFT turn into the property here. Proceed up the driveway and someone will help you park.

If you miss exit 30, or if you are coming from the east (past Antigonish town), you should turn at exit 31A to the north towards Brierly Brook. Again proceed 4.5 kilometers approximately, look for civic number 1851 and turn RIGHT up the driveway.

All the roads are paved. If you are on gravel, you have made a wrong turn. There will be lots of space for trailer parking but services are minimal, very few plug-ins and no sewer service for the trailers.

Please be courteous and leave the grounds the way you found them. Be sure your stall is clean when you leave.
