Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the show committee until 8 am on Sept. 17.

All horses must be registered (or registration pending) with the CHBA and must be entered by registered owner or leasee. A third party may show the horse and must have proof of insurance.

Classes may be combined or cancelled at the discretion of the show committee depending upon the number of entries received. A class with one entry may be held for demonstration purposes if appropriate.

**Safety is a priority.** A tack judge will be available to inspect saddles, carts, harness etc. The judge may excuse any unsafe vehicle or tack, unruly horse or driver/rider that is not in control. All riders must have appropriate footwear (boot with low heel). All junior riders (18 & under) must wear approved riding helmet.

The CNHP (Central Nova Horse and Pony Association) facility is located minutes outside Truro on the Old Salmon River Road, off of East Prince Street. Off the main road so there is no traffic or noise to contend

with. It is required that horses be vaccinated for Flu and Rhyno. On site are two barns which have a combined total of 50 box stalls however-- please BRING YOUR OWN BEDDING!! There is a warm up ring, very large show ring and approximately 230 acres with cross-country trails. There is also club house with a washroom.

There is plenty of room for parking and camping on site. Please be courteous and leave the grounds the way you find them. All stalls must be stripped down to the dirt floor and area in front of your stall (s) must be raked and clean.
